#### SACRAMENTS =

**BAPTISM:** Contact the parish office to meet with a priest or deacon. Baptism is celebrated by appointment on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 1 p.m.

**CONFIRMATION:** Students in grade eight are invited to prepare with their parents/guardians through St. Peter School or Denis Morris High School. Registration is required in September.

**EUCHARIST :** Children in grade two will be prepared for their First Eucharist with their parents through St. Peter School. Registration is required in September.

**RECONCILIATION:** Children in grade two will be prepared prior to First Eucharist. Parents will prepare their child and will bring them for their First Confession.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** During a serious or prolonged illness or before surgery. Families will call for the priest to anoint the sick person.

**MARRIAGE:** An initial appointment with a priest or deacon six months prior to your desired wedding date - no date will be set before meeting with a priest/deacon.

**VOCATIONS:** Those being called to the priesthood, diaconate or religious life are invited to make an appointment to speak with Fr. Greg or one of the deacons for information and referral.

#### BECOMING A CATHOLIC =

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA) will direct adults inquiring about becoming members of the Catholic Church through weekly prayer and instruction – Mondays @ 7:00 p.m. September through May. Contact a member of the pastoral team for information and registration.

**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR CHILDREN (RCIA)** will prepare children of catechetical age for baptism. One parent must be Catholic and the child is expected to be enrolled in our Catholic schools. Weekly participation in Children's Liturgy – Sundays @ 9:00 a.m. September through June. Contact a member of the pastoral team for information and registration.


#### **MINISTRIES**

### **AUGUST 23, 2020**

### **TWENTY FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

In our Gospel passage, from Matthew, Jesus poses a question to the disciples: "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" And they offer varying responses. Then, Jesus gets personal with them. "But who do you say that I am?" Peter gets the answer right: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."



Jesus is getting personal with us today. He poses the same question to each of us who call ourselves His stewards and modern-day disciples. But do our lives truly reflect this? If we really believe that Christ is the Son of God, sent to save us from our sins and lead us to Heaven, then we must say so, not just with words but with our actions. Do my ambitions and priorities in life say that Christ is my Savior and I am His disciple? Does my budget, my family life, my entertainment say so?

The gifts and blessings God has given us — our time, our talents, our material possessions — are meant to be used in a manner that says "Christ is my Savior and I am His disciple." The most eloquent praise we can offer Him is a life lived in grateful response to His unfathomable love. This is the beauty and power of a stewardship way of life.
