March 19, 2023 Fourth Sunday of Lent

At this point in our Lenten journey, it is tempting to grow weary of the spiritual disciplines we have taken on. Today's readings inspire us to remain faithful, in grateful response to a God who loves us so much. In our first reading, the prophet Ezekiel speaks God's own words to us. "I will put my spirit in you that you may live... I have promised and I will do it, says the Lord." Our God wants to be so closely united to us that we are one with Him. And He has promised He will do it. But only if we make room for Him by making Him THE priority of our lives. Putting God first is a grateful response that is very pleasing to Him. How can we do this? Our second reading, from Romans, tells us. "Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh... you are in the spirit if only the Spirit of God dwells in you."



The disciplines of Lent and a stewardship way of life are wonderful gifts that free us from too great an attachment to "the flesh." The sacrifices we make as Christian stewards are not meant to restrict our freedom and joy. Quite the contrary. They are tools to help us find the real freedom and joy that only come when we make room in our lives for God.

As we journey closer to the Passion of our Lord, let us intensify our Lenten resolutions and our stewardship way of life, inviting the Holy Spirit to take over more and more of our lives. By Easter, we will be freer to rejoice in Him and truly pleasing to God.



St. Julia SVDP Update

- As you are aware of the influx of refugees into Niagara Falls; the Niagara Falls SVDP store has
 given away most of its stock of goods to those in need. There is an urgent need for warm clothing
 and footwear for entire families. Small appliances like toasters and kettles, dishes, bedding, books,
 and small toys for the children are also needed. Used laptops and tablets are also useful. Tourist
 season will soon start and many of these refugees will need shelter as they wait for work permits.
- Food cards that support our clients average \$1600 monthly. The principal client receives \$100 and each additional family member \$50 in food cards towards groceries. St. Patrick's food bank is grateful for your ongoing food donations to the bin at the entrance to our church.
